Helensvale State High School 2025 Swimming Carnival General Information









- 1) The Swimming Carnival is over 2 days and is a whole of school event in 2025
- 2) Years 7-9 will attend the carnival on Thursday 13th February
- 3) Years 10-12 will attend the carnival on Friday 14th February
- 4) Years 10 12 will attend a normal school day on Thursday 13th February
- 5) Years 7 9 will attend a normal school day on the Friday 14th February
- 6) Arrival time to class should be as normal, students will go to regular timetabled roll mark classes.
- 7) Students may wear <u>appropriate</u> swimwear of their choice. One-piece, modest swimwear is preferred.

 Appropriate swimwear may include speedos, one piece, two-piece, board shorts and rash shirts.) Where possible, try to match swimwear to your house colour!
- 8) Students must have shirts and hats on when not racing.
- 9) Students may wear house colours to school, but no coloured hair spray or zinc as per the wishes of the Helensvale pool. These products can affect the water quality at the venue.
- 10) Footwear (e.g., covered shoes) must be worn to and from the pool.
- 11) Encourage students to leave valuables at home. Bags could be left unattended. The school does not accept responsibility for any such items e.g., phones, air pods etc., that may go missing. Phones as usual are to be left OFF and AWAY for the day prior to the beginning of the day.
- 12) CANTEEN there is a canteen available however it has minimal snacks and drinks therefore it is advised that students to bring packed lunch
- 13) WATER Students should bring 2 x water bottles
- 14) Students will be walking from the school to the Pool after roll mark and will be walking back from the pool to the school to be ready for collection by the end of the day.
- 15) Students can be dropped off/arrive at School as if it were a normal school day.
- 16) All students who attend are expected to swim (ideally in 2 events in their age groups). All levels of ability are catered for. This event tries to balance competition (championship and non- championship events (breast, freestyle and back) and fun events (novelty relays, bomb competition, house lap a thon challenge, noodle relay).
- 17) Students will be dismissed from 2:55pm (Thursday) and 1.15pm (Friday) from the school, not the venue.
- 18) Due to the smaller size of Helensvale pool and the numbers of students attending, we kindly ask that parents do not attend the Carnival as there is limited space available.

Helensvale State High School Swimming Carnival Further Information

Start of day and Transport

- Students are walking to the venue from the school and returning to the school at the end of the normal school day.
- Students should be in class to have their class roll checked by 8.40am

Parent - Parking (for drop off and pick up)

• Drop off and pick up will be at Helensvale State High School as if it were a normal school day

Spectators

Spectators are not encouraged to attend due to the small size of the venue and its capacity.

Food and Toilets

- NO CANTEEN for students to purchase lunch, only snacks and soft drinks sold.
- Students should bring food and at least 2 litres of water
- NO SCHEDULED LUNCH BREAK students manage own food throughout the day. Eat in house bays
- Students must gain permission from their house bay supervisor prior to going to the toilet

Racing and Events

- All Non-Championship (SOCIAL) students are expected to participate (ideally 2 events 25 breast, back and freestyle) students will be asked to make their way to the marshalling area in the age groups/gender prior to their chosen events.
- All non-championship/social races are 25m. One length of the pool.
- The more races students enter the more house points.
- If swimmers are struggling half way through a race it is OK to hold onto the lane ropes
- You do not need to dive from the blocks beside the blocks or in the pool is fine
- If you are not confident (tell the teacher at marshalling) and swim in Lane 1 or 8
- House coloured swim caps will be provided for the house finals you are expected to swim in these

End of Day Process

- Students are expected to stay for the duration of the event to support their peers. Signing out early
 is strongly discouraged. Any early sign out will be facilitated through the usual school process, that is,
 parents/carers contact student hub, message will be sent to pool, students will be accompanied by
 learning community staff to return to the office for collection. Early sign outs are likely to experience
 lengthy delays. Again, this is strongly discouraged.
- Presentations at 2:30pm will acknowledge age group champions & the overall House Champion
- 2:40pm students travel back to school by foot
