THE PURPOSE OF YEAR 9



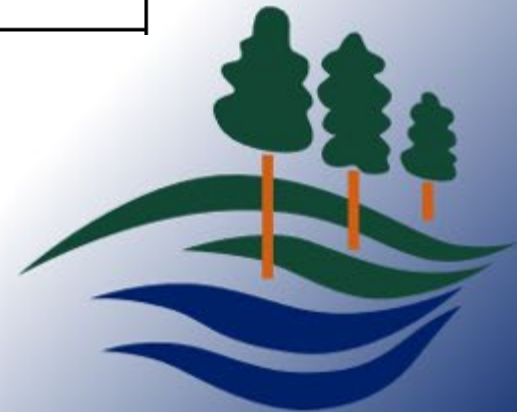
Year 9 is the final year of Junior Secondary at Helensvale State High School.

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SOME RULES FOR ACADEMY

- If you are in Sports Academy, you will still do six months of HPE as it is compulsory.
- If you are in the Arts Academy Program, you can't choose a six month elective of the same subject. Eg. Academy Dance students cannot choose the Dance elective, but you could choose Drama.
- If you are in the Japanese Academy, you can't choose Japanese as an additional elective.
- If you are in the e4e Academy, you can't choose Business & Economics as an additional elective.

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FAQ

If I am not in an Academy, can I just choose it on my subject selection for next year?

Answer – No. You must go and see the Academy Director to find out how to apply for the Academy in 2026.
