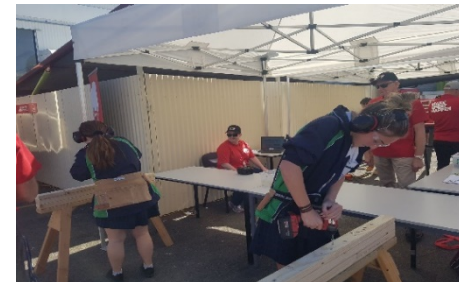

SATS

(School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships)

1. To be eligible for a SAT, students must meet a minimum standard of attendance and behaviour.



2. At HSHS, only students intending on studying a Vocational Pathway can complete a SAT.

3. The ILO will work with students to achieve a suitable placement and best outcome.

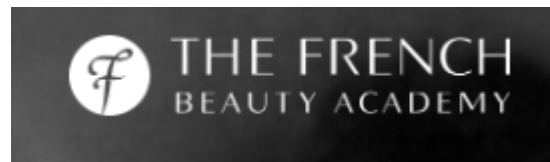
4. A SAT must align with your intended Career or Study Pathway.

Things to consider: External Courses

1. Course must align with your intended Career or Study Pathway



Example:

To become a Plumber -
Begin with Cert II Plumbing

2. You must have the academic ability to complete the qualification



Example:

Electrotechnology - a pass in Year 10
General Mathematics and successfully
complete the TAFE math's self assessment
tool

3. Transport - Parents are responsible for transport arrangements



4. You are eligible to study 1 x VETiS funded qualification whilst at school



How to Apply for External Courses

- ▶ Return the 'Application for External Course' form to the Industry Liaison Officer in KS10. Both student and parent will be contacted to schedule a meeting to complete the online enrolment process once the HOD/Deputy Principal have assessed the application and approved the enrolment to go ahead.
- ▶ Applications open as soon as you have completed your SETP! Some courses fill very quickly so it is recommended you complete this process as soon as possible.
- ▶ Completing an Application does not guarantee the course will proceed and you will gain placement, each course will depend on numbers from various schools on the Gold Coast.
- ▶ Enrolments will be confirmed by the colleges via email to both students and parents before the end of the school year.
- ▶ Students must choose 6 Subjects at the time of Subject Selection - after commencement of the course, students may apply to drop a subject in 2023.

intending on studying a Vocational Pathway***

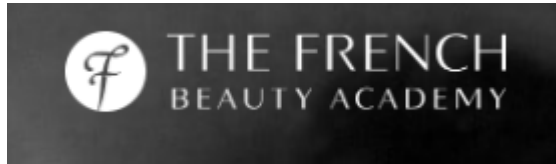

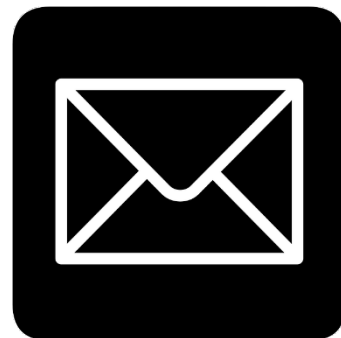
