ENTRANCE WORKSHOP

As part of your students' application for the Helensvale State High **Education 4 Entrepreneurs** Academy Program we require students to participate in a Workshop to demonstrate their current knowledge of the following criteria:

Creativity: Innovation, design, continuous improvement.Collaboration: Teamwork, leadership, problem solving.Communication: Confidence, Public speaking, presentation skills.

Students who demonstrate creativity, drive, enthusiasm to succeed, and make a difference to the future should apply. As places in the Academy Program are limited, participation in the Workshop is considered an important component of their overall application.
