## **Student Resource Scheme**

The scheme will supply students with access to:

- Photographic student ID card for external use (replacement ID card is \$10)
- All prescribed textbooks for each subject
- Administration of the scheme
- Daily Laptop Hire (Not the student Laptop Program)
- Equipment hire digital cameras (still/video), audio visual equipment, a wide range of industry standard software
- Equipment hire some musical instruments
- Use of equipment, consumable materials and photocopies for a range of subjects across all year levels
- Class sets of general reading novels
- Other student reference books
- Access to electronic diary
- Printed worksheets/handouts/notes and equipment prepared by teachers
- Audio and video recordings

- Preparation, practice and marking for National Literacy & Numeracy testing provided by external agency
- Career pathways expos and information
- Unique Personal Development Programs
- Industry placement services
- School-based apprenticeship/traineeship placement services
- Qld Core Skills preparation, practice & marking
- Mathletics available for home use
- Minor equipment e.g. graphic calculators
- Materials for subjects where the instruction is extended through providing practical learning experiences in excess of materials provided by school grants
- Interschool Sport Uniform and equipment
- Various subject resources
- Various Friday Afternoon Sport/Student Activities
- Cluster Sport & Interhouse Sport Activities

These resources are provided on loan. Students are expected to take due care of all items and to return them, in a condition similar to that in which they were issued, on completion of a unit of study or upon leaving the school.
